4. A Seventy Dollar (**US\$70**) application fee (courier charges apply if application is mailed in)
5. Birth Certificate **OR** Adoption Certificate;
6. Expired Jamaican Passport **OR** Certificate of Jamaican Citizenship (where applicable);
7. A Photo ID issued by a Federal Government or State agency.
